

## **Mission Statement**

Valencia Town Center will continue in its evolution as a superior shopping experience due to its better tenant mix, best in class dining and family retail as it systematically replaces under-performing stores with emerging brands and highly productive retailers, food operators, entertainment and service providers.

# **Design Guidelines**

- **Storefront Height** –Varies from 12'-10" to 16'-1" depending on the zone (Inline) or 15'-0" to 28'-0" depending on the zone (The Patios)
- Glass Height 11'-0" Minimum, depending on the zone (Inline) or 12'0" Minimum (The Patios)
- Glass Door Height 10'-0" Minimum
- Design Control Zone Entire sales area to be hard lid, hard surface flooring, concealed track lighting
- **Transparency Percentage** Exact number (80% glass, 20% opaque). However, higher storefront may have more opaque area due to construction requirement and deck height.
- **Signage Height** Exact height or range (12"-18" signage, face-lighted no trim cap, reverse channel halo or illuminated push through letters) or 24" max letter/logo, 36" max if stacked (The Patios)
- Blade Signage not permitted in main concourse ancillary wings only (Inline only) or varies depending on zone (The Patios)
- Window Signage 2" frosted 3M film applied to inside face of window.
- **Bulkhead Conditions** Tenant to demolish or clad over with tenant finishes as required to achieve zone height (Inline only) or base building/tenant not to touch (The Patios)
- **Neutral Pier Conditions** <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" black reveal (Inline only) or base building/tenant not to touch NP (The Patios)

### **MEP** Criteria

- Mechanical system type mall central VAV system (Inline) or RTU systems by tenant (The Patios)
- Electrical conditions 277/480V
- Smoke Evac None

# **Permit Process**

- **Standard length of process** Permit time is average 4 6 weeks (approx. 3 weeks with paid expedited review)
- Need Landlord approved drawings to submit? No
- **Precon is required** Tenant GC to set up meeting with Facilities Manager prior to start.
- Licensed GC required for permit issuance
